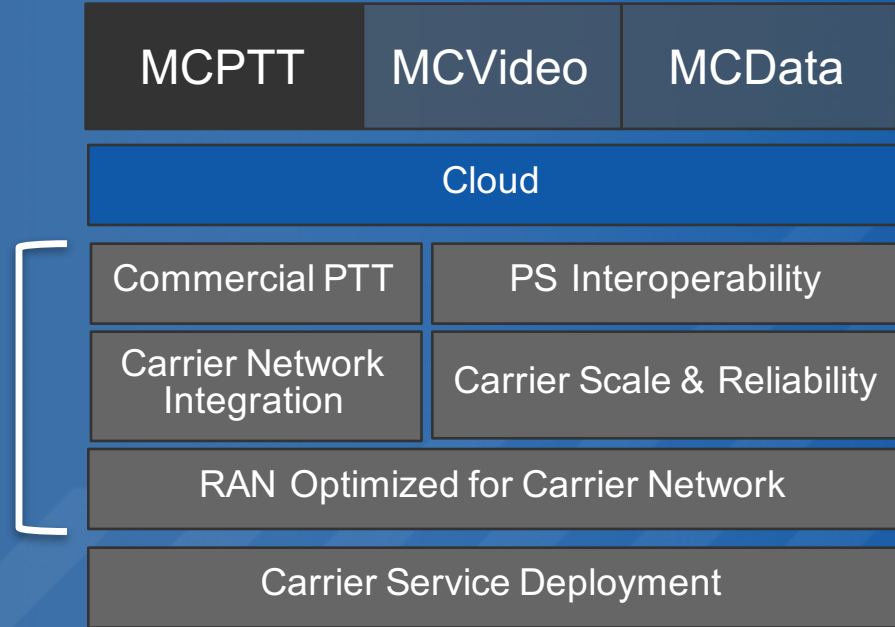

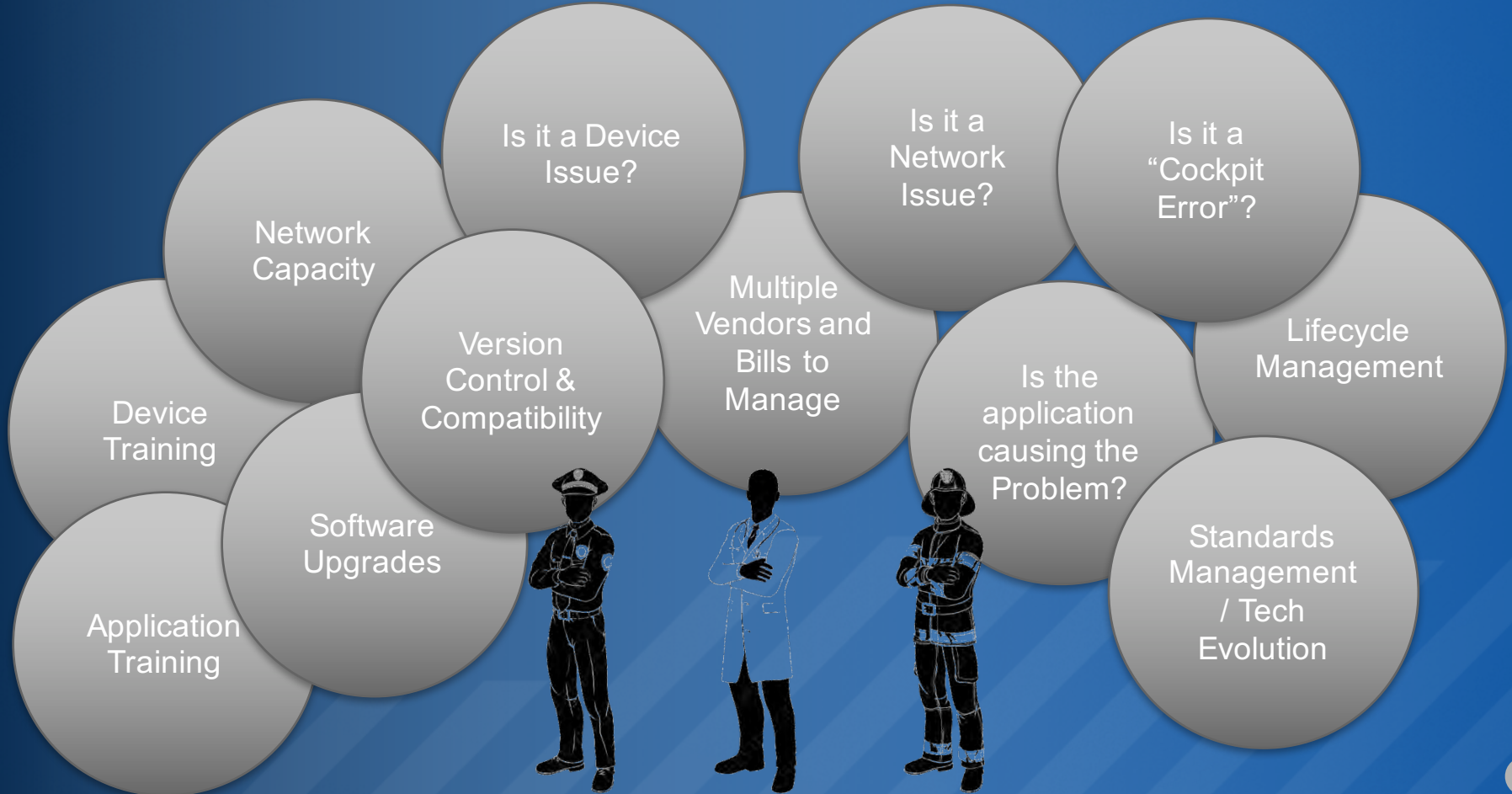




Public safety voice on broadband takes more than building to a standard
